

## Do's and don'ts

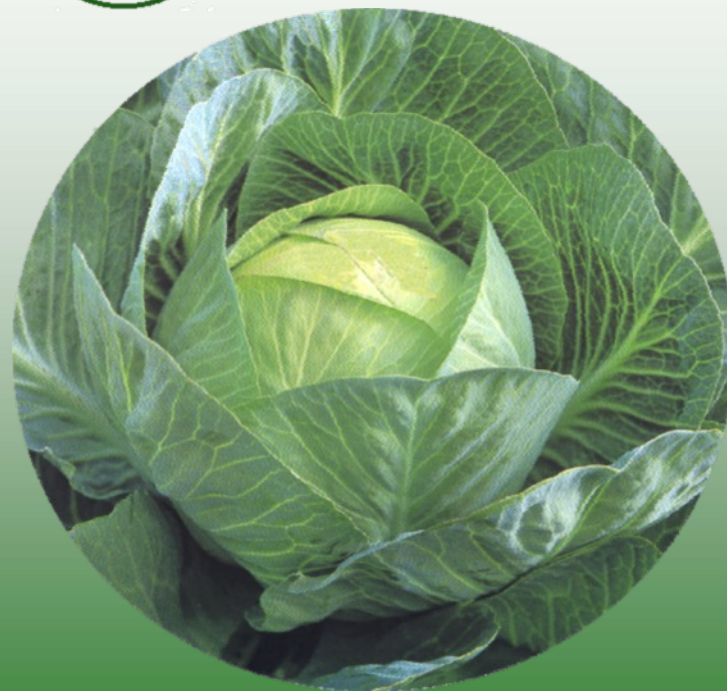
- Adapt your variety to marketing choices
- Adjust plant spacing to head-size requirements
- Practice field hygiene- Plough in residues immediately after harvest.
- Planting seasons will vary from area to area
- Ask us to sample you with new varieties for testing
- Select and vary varieties according to season
- Constantly test other varieties in your area
- Don't discard a variety on hearsay or a single trial
- Keep hawkers vehicles out of your lands
